PUBLIC CONSULTATION: Ingleby Barwick War Memorial - Proposed Erection of Ornamental Railings.

Ingleby Barwick War Memorial, which was provided by Ingleby Barwick Town Council, is sited at a prominent central location adjacent to the main entrance into Romano Park.

As residents will be aware, 2014 is the Centenary of the beginning of the First World War.

Ingleby Barwick Town Council is currently looking to erect ornamental railings, funded by the Town Council, which would be positioned around the outer edge of the War Memorial.

It is proposed that these be erected in 2014 to commemorate the Centenary. The railings would provide a secure place to which we can attach wreaths etc. Currently, wreaths are laid loosely at the War Memorial and are subject to being blown around in inclement weather.
