Details of Public Inquiry in Respect of Planning Application No. 14/0208/OUT Outline Application for Residential Development of up to 550 Homes including Provision of Means of Access and Open Space on Land Adjacent to Thornaby Road, Ingleby Barwick, Stockton-on-Tees

Following refusal of the planning application by Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council the applicant has appealed to the Secretary of State for the Environment under Section 78 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The Secretary of State has appointed an Inspector to determine the appeal which will be dealt with by way of a Public Inquiry. The Inquiry will take place at **10:00** on **10th February 2015** at **Stockton Baptist Tabernacle, The Auditorium, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1TE**
