Proposed Community Centre, The Rings, Ingleby Barwick

As residents will be aware, Ingleby Barwick Town and Ward Councillors are working in partnership with Stockton Borough Council (S.B.C.) and Persimmon Homes, to provide a new Community Centre, within Village 6, The Rings, Ingleby Barwick.

The ground floor layout will be similar to the existing Community Centre situated within Village 2, Beckfields. It will cater for local groups and will provide for activities such as Guides, Scouts, Dance Classes and other community interests. A number of 'expressions of interest' to use the facility have already been received.

A permanent office for Ingleby Barwick Town Council will also be provided.

The proposed building will also incorporate the long awaited and much needed 'Youth Cafe' facility on the upper floor.

The design and plans have been drawn up by an architect and a planning application will be submitted to S.B.C. Planning Department in the near future, to obtain approval.

The financial implications of providing the Community Centre and associated works are currently being considered and further information on this will be provided in due course.

A public meeting was held on a 'drop in' basis on Saturday 28th February 2015 at the Community Hall on Haresfield Way, when residents were invited to come along to view the plans and find out more about the project.

The Town Council will keep you informed on progress.
